

HIRING GANG ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

This is a new position to our City and will require an applicant that is self motivated and has the expertise to identify and document gangs and their activities within our City. The selected applicant will be required to educate the public as well as the Police Department to any gang activities.

On the date of employment, applicants must; be at least 21 years of age; must be a Utah resident & a U.S. citizen; possess a valid Utah Drivers License; possess a high school diploma or G.E.D. equivalent; not have a conviction for a felony or any crime involving domestic violence; read, write, speak, and understand English; Utah P.O.S.T. certified or certifiable.

Starting pay range \$18.34 hr. to \$21.38 hr. based on qualifications and experience. Employment will include a generous benefits package, assigned vehicle, equipment, uniform.
